Our PACE program follows a model that blends self-contained core courses with inclusion in specials. The PACE Teacher must be responsible and proactive as he or she may perform a wide range of tasks in order to support the learning and behavior goals of each student. In our PACE program, the teacher is managing a class of up to ten students, teaching a modified curriculum, and serving students at varying grade levels and responding to individual needs. Our PACE teacher is developing social skills (Social Thinking, Zones of Regulation), student independence, and meeting curricular goals in ELA, math, social studies, and science. The PACE Teacher is responsible for Student Accommodation Plans, modifying assignments, collaborating with teachers, behavior modification and plans, parent conferences, and regular communication with colleagues and parents. Teachers are required to develop the use of educational technology in the classroom and promote and support student digital literacy. Having patience and solid communication skills are also highly recommended to be successful in this role. An excellent and positive rapport with students, teachers, and parents is a must as is a respect and high regard for the dignity of every child. Experience in a similar inclusive setting is a plus. Candidates must possess a special education degree or licensure; some social skills and behavior management training is preferred. Candidates must provide a resume, cover letter, and three references from supervisors.
