The following medical doctors have indicated that they practice without prescribing, performing, or referring for contraception, sterilization, abortion, or in vitro fertilization. They promote Natural Family Planning for achieving or avoiding conception. However, a provider may work among colleagues in a practice that does provide contraception.

In addition, the list references those doctors who practice <u>NaProTechnology</u> (Natural Procreative Technology) and/or <u>FEMM Medical Management</u>. These are medical programs that focus on restoring normal function and cooperate completely with the reproductive system to restore menstrual health and fertility, also called <u>Restorative Reproductive Medicine</u>.
